



Millbrae & Burlingame Shoreline Area Project Engagement Summary – July 2024

OneShoreline’s Millbrae and Burlingame Shoreline Area Protection and Enhancement Project (Project) aims to build long-term climate resilience for developed, natural, and public access areas of this portion of the Bay shoreline of San Mateo County. During the summer of 2020, OneShoreline staff began outreach to city staff and elected officials, property owners, regulatory staff, organizations, and other interested parties to discuss the Project. Over the past four years, staff have hosted or attended nearly 100 meetings described in the following summary table to present on the Project, answer questions, and receive feedback.

Purposes of engagement to date include:

- With City of Burlingame staff and shoreline developers, coordinate the planning and design of proposed developments with the City’s zoning ordinance and the Project
- With City staff and property owners, secure necessary data and discuss Project alternatives
- Coordination on site-specific sea level rise requirements and Project connections with property owners
- Receive input from regulatory staff regarding Project alternatives
- Update and receive input from organizations and city elected officials

Key takeaways from these conversations include:

- Interest in follow-up conversations
- Interest in public outreach beyond the CEQA process, and concerns about outreach associated with the Notice of Preparation as part of the CEQA process
- Interest in sea level rise resilience for the Project area, as part of OneShoreline’s regional approach
- Concerns about wildlife attractants, water quality, and the feasibility of permitting the Project
- Interest in Project phasing and details about potential habitat elements and how those elements will evolve over various sea level rise scenarios
- Interest in clearly defined Project benefits for local city drainage and inland creek flooding

While this outreach effort was extensive, this complicated and constrained climate adaptation project requires meaningful collaboration with many stakeholders and significant engagement work remains. Thus, following contract authorization by the Board on May 20, 2024, OneShoreline hired a Project outreach consultant – Civic Edge Consulting – to develop and implement a plan for additional outreach over the next two years. Key audiences for the plan include the elected officials, staff, and residents from/visitors to the cities of Millbrae, Burlingame, and San Mateo; community-based organizations and advocacy groups; technical experts; environmental regulators; and landowners.
