



AMENDMENT NO. 1

TO THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR

Lower Colma Creek Resilience Projects: San Mateo Avenue to Utah Avenue

On January 7, 2025, OneShoreline published a Request for Proposals for the development of a biddable construction package for improvements on a tidally influenced reach of Colma Creek located within the City of South San Francisco. The original deadline to respond was February 11, 2025, at 5:00 PM.

OneShoreline amends the Request for Proposals to extend the deadline to February 19, 2025, at 5:00 PM local time and make amendments to the RFP schedule. No other revisions are made to the Request for Proposals (RFP).

1. Extension of Deadline to Respond.

The deadline to respond listed on the RFP cover page and under the section of the RFP entitled “Submittal Process” is hereby replaced in its entirety with the following: “February 19, 2025, at 5:00 PM”.

The final two paragraphs under the section of the RFP entitled “Submittal Process,” are hereby replaced in its entirety with the following:

“Additionally, questions submitted by email to Projects@OneShoreline.org with the subject line ‘Lower Colma Creek Resilience Projects RFP’ by February 7 at 5:00 PM will be answered in a FAQ document posted at [OneShoreline.org/document-library](https://www.oneshoreline.org/document-library) by February 11 at 5:00 PM, along with any RFP addenda. Answers to questions may additionally be provided at earlier dates. Proposals shall be valid for one hundred twenty (120) days.

Interviews of prospective consultants may be expected to occur March 5, 6, and 7 in person at OneShoreline’s offices at 1700 South El Camino Real, San Mateo, CA.”

2. All Other Terms Unaffected.

All other terms and conditions in the RFP are unaffected by this Amendment and shall remain in full force and effect.
