



Colma Creek Watershed Plan of Opportunities and Feasibility to Meet Long-term Multi-Benefit Resilience Objectives

Responses to Questions Regarding the RFP 1 — February 11, 2025

Q1 Would OneShoreline consider increasing the 20-page count limit?

A1 The page count limit will be increased to 25 pages.

Q2 Can the graphic cover, table of contents, and resumes/bios be excluded from the page count limit?

A2 The cover may be excluded from the page limit. A maximum of eight (8) 2-page resumes may be excluded from the page limit. The table of contents is included in the page limit.

Q3 Can font smaller than 11-point be used on graphics/diagrams?

A3 9-point font may be used on graphics/diagrams.

Q4 Can 11x17 inserts be used, each counting as 1 page?

A4 An 11x17 size page may be used and counted as one page for the organizational chart, project schedule, fee schedule, and one exhibit of your choice. Additional 11x17 pages will count as two pages and should be numbered as such.

Q5 Can the deadline to respond to this RFP be extended?

A5 Yes, the deadline to respond has been extended in Addenda 1 on the project page [here](#). OneShoreline does not anticipate additional extensions to the deadline.

Q6 Will the cover page, table of contents, resumes and/or the Non-Collusion and Conflict of Interest Statement be excluded from the page count?

A6 Please see responses A1 and A2.

Q6 Is there a desired completion timeline?

A6 At this time OneShoreline anticipates the project will be completed within 24 months and proposal recommendations will be considered.

Q7 Public engagement seems limited, is that because you anticipate relying on the input gained during the Resilient by Design process?

A7 Consultant shall reference Task 1 Project Management and Partner Engagement including assumptions for support to present at public meetings.
