If your goal is:

To redirect water away from your home, consider:



Gutters & roof drainage

Direct roof runoff away from walls and foundation



Ground drainage

Moves standing water out of low areas



Sealants & membranes

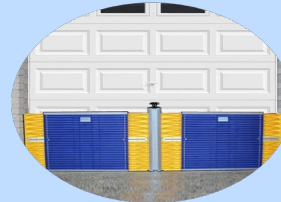
Close small cracks or leaks in foundation walls or floors

To keep water from entering your home, consider:



Permanent flood gates

Fixed, custom-fit panels that provide watertight protection at entryways.



Semi-attached flood gates

Hinged panels that stay mounted beside doors and lock into place.



Modular flood barriers

Removable panels deployed to form temporary wall to block water.

To prevent sewage backup, consider:



Backflow prevention valve

Plumber-installed device that blocks sewage from backing up through drains during heavy rain

QUICK TIPS

Flood resilience works best when you build from the outside-in.

Start with measures that keep water away from your home, then seal or pump out water that does get in. Once the source is under control, reduce indoor moisture with a dehumidifier and keep preparedness tools on hand.

Flood supplies are for renters too!

Portable options like flood barriers, shelving, dehumidifiers, sensors, and protective gear help protect your space and belongings without altering the property. For larger improvements labeled by a ✂, consider contacting your landlord or property manager.

If your goal is:

To manage water and moisture in your home or crawlspace, consider:



Sump pump

Permanently installed to remove water where it commonly pools



Portable water pump

Can be set up temporarily to remove standing water as necessary



Dehumidifier

Removes moisture from the air and prevents mold and musty smells

To protect your belongings and utilities if water enters, consider:



Utility platform

Elevates utilities (like washing machines) above floor level



Shelving

Elevates appliances, electronics, and valuables above floor level



Waterproof containers

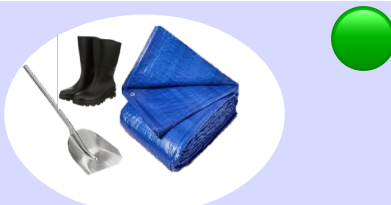
Watertight bins and/or bags

To stay alert and ready, consider:



Flood alert system

Detects and warns of water in garages, crawl spaces, or basements



Clean up & protective gear

Gloves, masks, boots, and disinfectant for post-flood cleanup
